- Immunization Forms
  - Submit immunization forms via the new <u>Student Self-Service Portal</u>
- Health Insurance Waiver
  - You are required to complete/submit a health insurance waiver <u>EVERY year!</u> The deadline for fall semester is September 2023 (specific date not posted yet)
  - When you complete/submit the waiver in the <u>Student Self-</u> <u>Service Portal</u>, you will indicate one of the following:
    - You have health insurance coverage (i.e. your parents, spouse, etc.); you will have to provide/submit proof of insurance coverage/plan
    - You are enrolled/will enroll in UF GatorGradCare for Graduate Assistants

- Following a significant research experience with mentor
- 90 days after signing contract to form committee and meet
- Does not affect funding!
